COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1476, L.D. 2116, Bill, "An Act to Provide Funds for a National World War II Memorial in Washington"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 (page 1, lines 3 to 16 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

**Miscellaneous Acts and Resolves**

All Other \$109,000

Provides funds on a one-time basis to the National World War II Memorial Fund.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
