Defining or distinguishing routine maintenance and major 20 maintenance expenditures; Reviewing the present system for rating maintenance, 22 4. repair and other capital projects; 24 5. Reviewing the State's leasing practices; 26 6. Reviewing the State's fixed asset inventory system; 28 7. Reviewing the State's debt policies; 30 8. Developing a debt policy that integrates capital 32 planning and debt affordability; 34 9. Reviewing the feasibility of developing a 4-year capital plan including a project tracking system; and 36 10. Developing and presenting a capital budget to policy 38 makers separate from the operating budget; and be it further Sec. 3. Recommendations. Resolved: 40 That the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, the State Planning Office, 42 the Department of Transportation and the Office of Treasurer of State shall make recommendations about the State's capital 44 planning process to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs by December 31, 1999. The Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs 46 may report out legislation as necessary to implement the recommendations of the reporting group to the Second Regular 48 Session of the 119th Legislature. 50

SUMMARY

2 This resolve authorizes a group of agencies to conduct a 4 comprehensive review of the State's capital budgeting process, with recommendations to be made to the Joint Standing Committee 6 on Appropriations and Financial Affairs by December 31, 1999. The committee may report out legislation as necessary to 8 implement the recommendations of the reporting group.
