	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2104, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1989, c.
4	104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is repealed.
6	Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §2104, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:
8	4-A. Direct submission to voters. Nothing in this section may be construed to require the submission of a petition by
10	voters, in accordance with subsections 2 and 3, to be treated as a request for a charter commission unless specifically requested
12	in the petition. A proposed amendment to the municipal charter filed in accordance with subsections 2, 3 and 5 must be placed on
14	the ballot in accordance with subsection 2.

	This bill allows the submission of a petition for a
20	municipal charter revision directly to the voters in that municipality, without the creation of a charter commission, if
22	specifically requested by the petitioners. A petition submitted in this manner still must meet certain requirements, such as a
24	determination of sufficiency and a public hearing.
