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## FISCAL NOTE

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The Board of Dental Examiners within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur some minor additional costs to amend rules regarding public health supervision of dental hygienists. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

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10 SUMMARY

This amendment changes the title and format of the bill and directs the Board of Dental Examiners to amend the rule regarding public health supervision of dental hygienists in order to provide less restrictive public health supervision of dental hygienists. The purpose of the rule change is to encourage greater utilization of services in institutional, public health and other settings outside a dental office. Rules adopted pursuant to this provision are designated as routine technical rules. The amendment adds a fiscal note.

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
