
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Further amendment the amendment by inserting after section 1

appointed pursuant to Title 5, section 13080-B, subsection 2" and
inserting in its place the following: 'the Governor shall
solicit nominations and appoint a new member to fill the seat
from the municipalities listed in Title 5, section 13080-B,
subsection 2, paragraph C, subparagraph (1)''
