COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1498, L.D. 2142, Bill, "An Act to Change Laws Pertaining to the Loring Development Authority of Maine"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13080-B, sub-§2, ¶C, as amended by PL 1995, c. 166, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

C. The Governor shall appoint 12 trustees as follows:

(1) Six trustees who are residents of Aroostook County and who are nominated as follows:

(a) One trustee nominated by the City of Caribou;

(b) One trustee nominated by the Town of Limestone;

(c) One trustee nominated by the Town of Caswell;

(d) One trustee nominated by the Town of Fort Fairfield;

(e) One trustee nominated by the City of Presque Isle; and

(f) One trustee nominated by the Town of Van Buren.

A trustee nominated by a municipality listed in this subparagraph need not be a resident of the nominating municipality.

If a municipality listed in this subparagraph does not nominate a trustee, the Governor shall appoint, in place of a nominee from that municipality, a trustee from Aroostook County who is nominated by any municipality in Aroostook County that chooses to submit a nomination:

(2) One trustee who is a resident of Aroostook County and nominated by any municipality in Aroostook County that chooses to submit a nomination other than the municipalities listed in subparagraph (1);

(3) Four trustees who are not residents of Aroostook County; and

(4) One trustee who is a resident of this State.'

SUMMARY

This amendment reconfigures the composition of the board of trustees for the Loring Development Authority of Maine and clarifies the nomination and appointment process.
