## An Act to Change Laws Pertaining to the Loring Development Authority of Maine.

•	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA $13080$ -B, sub- $2$ , $C$ , as amended by PL 1995, c. 166, $1$ , is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6	C. The Governor shall make 12 appointments, of which 7 must be candidates who are residents of Aroostook County and
8	nominated as follows:
10	(1) One member nominated by the City of Caribou;
12	(2) One member nominated by the Town of Limestone;
14	(3) One member nominated by the Town of Caswell;
16	(4) Three members nominated by any municipality in Aroostook County other than the municipalities listed
18	in subparagraphs (1), (2) and (3); and
20	(5) One member nominated by the county commissioners of Aroostook County.
22	Of the 5 remaining appointments, at least 4 must be
24	candidates who are not residents of Aroostook County.
26	Sec. 2. Transition provision. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 13080-B, subsection 2, a person who is
28	a member of the board of trustees of the Loring Development Authority of Maine on the effective date of this Act shall
30	continue to serve as a member until the member's term expires. When a vacancy occurs on the board of trustees for a seat that
32	must be reserved for a candidate who is a resident of Aroostook County pursuant to Title 5, section 13080-B, subsection 2,
34	paragraph C, a new member to fill the seat must be nominated and appointed pursuant to Title 5, section 13080-B, subsection 2.
36	Nominations and appointments of vacated seats must be made pursuant to Title 5, section 13080-B, subsection 2 until the
38	board of trustees conforms entirely to that subsection.
40	SUMMARY
42	This bill reconfigures the composition of the board of
44	trustees for the Loring Development Authority of Maine so that the City of Caribou, the Town of Caswell and the Town of
46	Limestone each nominate one member to the board; 3 members of the

48 County; and one member is nominated by the county commissioners of Aroostook County. This bill also allows the current members

of the board of trustees to finish their terms and the reconfigured board to be phased in as the current members' terms expire.

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
