2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. PL 1997, c. 752, §44** is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 44. Maine Governmental Facilities Authority; resolution for**
7 **issuance of securities.** Pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes,
8 Title 4, section 1606, subsection 2, the Maine Governmental
9 Facilities Authority is authorized to issue securities in its own
10 name in an amount up to ~~\$85,000,000~~ \$17,500,000 for the purpose
11 of paying the cost associated with the correctional ~~facilities~~
12 facility construction ~~prejects~~ project located in Warren--and
Windham.

14 **Sec. 2. Commissioner of Corrections to stop prison construction.**
15 The Commissioner of Corrections shall terminate any activities
16 involving a correctional facility construction project in the
17 Town of Warren.

20 **SUMMARY**

22 This bill stops the construction of a correctional facility
23 in the Town of Warren and revokes authorization to the Maine
24 Governmental Facilities Authority to borrow money for the project.
