HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1514, L.D. 2162, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Allow Persons with Mental Illness to Vote"

Amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the title by striking out all of the 4th, 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 33 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

' "Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to end discrimination against persons under guardianship for mental illness for the purpose of voting?" '
