SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report. It amends the original bill by lowering the proposed legislative pay increase from 50% to 3% in each year of the biennium. It also adds a provision that requires an annual cost-of-living adjustment to legislators' salaries. The amendment also removes provisions from the bill that would have required increases in constituent service allowances and the salaries of some constitutional officers and that would have reduced from 10 to 8 years the number of years required for legislative retirement eligibility. This amendment also authorizes the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government to report out legislation on legislative compensation in the Second Regular Session of the 119th Legislature.

The amendment also adds an appropriation section and fiscal note to the bill.
