30	behalf of those students. This requirement represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional
32	local costs can not be determined but will be significant. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least
34	90% of the additional costs or a Mandate Preamble is amended to
36	the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, the school
38	administrative units may not be required to implement these changes.'
