30	FISCAL NOTE
32	This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriation,
34	reducing the General Fund cost of the bill by \$3,600 in fiscal year 2000-01. This amendment removes the provisions creating the
36	study commission, eliminating the associated costs to the Legislature and the associated minor costs to the Department of
38	Public Safety and the Department of the Attorney General.
40	As amended, this bill may increase prosecutions for Class D crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to
42	the counties are estimated to be \$83.36 per day per prisoner.
