'FISCAL NOTE

4 The Maine Forest Service within the Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to develop 6 certain recommendations pertaining to liquidation harvesting and to submit a required report to the Legislature. These costs can 8 be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

The amendment directs the Maine Forest Service to develop 14 recommendations to address poor forest practices. The Maine Forest Service is directed to define poor forest practices and 16 timber liquidation harvesting. It also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
