Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Maine Residents Property Tax Program; outreach. The Bureau of Revenue Services, within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, shall conduct outreach activities to encourage maximum participation in the Maine Residents Property Tax Program by eligible taxpayers. The costs of these outreach activities must be paid from the amounts appropriated for the Maine Residents Property Tax Program.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment requires the Bureau of Revenue Services to fund the costs of outreach activities to encourage maximum participation in the Maine Residents Property Tax Program. These additional expenditures for outreach from the amounts appropriated to the program will decrease amounts available for this program. These expenditures may also increase participation in the program. Additional General Fund appropriations may be requested to fund program shortfalls as a result of this amendment.
