4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§80 is enacted to read:**

6 **80. Feminine hygiene products. Sales of feminine hygiene**
8 **products. For purposes of this subsection, "feminine hygiene**
10 **products" means those products used internally or externally to**
12 **absorb menstrual flow.**
