COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1533, L.D. 2186, Bill, "An Act to Authorize York County to Hold Bond Referenda for New County Facilities"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the bill in Part B by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. B-1. To raise money for the construction of county office facilities for York County. The county commissioners of York County are authorized to raise and expend a sum not to exceed \$5,000,000 for construction of county office facilities located in York County.'

Further amend the bill in Part B in section 3 in the first and 2nd lines (page 3, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the county courthouse addition" and inserting in its place the following: 'county office facilities'

Further amend the bill in Part B by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:
