28	The Bureau of Revenue Services will require additional
30	General Fund appropriations to avoid further increases in the backlog of cases in the bureau's appellate division and to pay
32	for a taxpayer's costs, including attorney's fees, in certain circumstances. The amount of the additional General Fund
34	appropriations can not be determined at this time.
	The Department of the Attorney General will incur additional
36	costs to handle certain taxpayer complaints against the Bureau of Revenue Services. The Department of the Attorney General assumes
38	that the additional activities associated with the change will be minimal and the costs associated with these activities can be
40	absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.
12	This bill may increase the number of civil suits filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative
14	costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can
16	be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional filing fees may also
18	increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
