
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1590, L.D. 2235, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Regarding Surface Use on Great Ponds"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 35 by inserting at the end a new blocked paragraph to read:

'This subsection is repealed 90 days after adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 119th Legislature.'

SUMMARY

The bill enacts restrictions on the use of personal watercraft on certain ponds within certain towns. This amendment repeals those restrictions 90 days after adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 119th Legislature.
