SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1598, L.D. 2243, Bill, "An Act to Promote Research and Development Activities in Maine"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This amendment eliminates several appropriations that were included in the original bill. It deappropriates funds from the Maine Science and Technology Foundation to offset funding for the ScienceWorks for ME program, the Maine Research Internships for Teachers and Students program and to expand the Department of Education's partnership with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.


