## **'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill may result in the expansion of the Capital Riverfront Improvement District, but it does not affect the cap on the amount of securities that the district may issue.

An increase in the number of members in the governing board, 18 if approved by the governing board, may increase the costs incurred by the State for participation in governing board 20 activities. Any costs associated with this additional participation are expected to be minor and can be absorbed by the 22 affected state agencies.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. It requires the 28 district governing board to elect cochairs. The amendment also authorizes the district to alter the district boundaries once 30 prior to August 31, 2000 without legislative approval. The amendment also deletes a reporting requirement on the district 32 master plan to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
