SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1627, L.D. 2274, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Authority of Maine Game Wardens to Stop Motor Vehicles"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Clarify the Authority of Maine Game Wardens'


Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the language that allows game wardens to stop vehicles.
