2	Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §436, as amended by PL 1999, c. 72, §8, is

6	§436. Grants for technical assistance and research
8	The commissioner may use all or a portion of the accrued interest in the cash balance of the Agricultural Marketing Loan
10	Fund and interest portion of loan repayments, up to a maximum of \$250,000 per year, for grants for technical assistance and the
12	agricultural development grant program in chapter 10. The commissioner may expend grant dollars designated to an applicant
14	in one fiscal year during the following fiscal year.
