This resolve includes a General Fund appropriation of \$202,026 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Human 12 Services to increase the reimbursement rates for speech and 14 language pathologist and audiologist services under Medicaid by 18%. The estimated future costs will be approximately \$202,026 annually beginning in fiscal year 2001-02. This amount includes 16 the costs of the rate increase for services to Medicaid clients 18 of the Department of Education, Child Development Services System. This estimate does not include any additional costs that 20 may be incurred by the Child Development Services System if the system provides a similar increase in the rate for services 22 provided by independent contractors to non-Medicaid children.

24 This resolve also includes a Federal Expenditures Fund allocation of \$394,713 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Human Services for the federal match associated with the rate 26 increase. The estimated future costs will be approximately \$394,713 annually beginning in fiscal year 2001-02. 28

30 The additional costs associated with adopting rules and conducting a study of reimbursement rates can be absorbed within 32 the existing budgeted resources of the Department of Human Services.'

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### **SUMMARY**

38 This amendment changes the title and replaces the resolve. It is the report of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and 40 Human Services. It amends the resolve to add an increase in Medicaid fees for audiologists and calls for a study of 42 reimbursement rates under the Medicaid program for all providers of health care services. It requires a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 44 health and human services matters by January 15, 2001. It adds 46 appropriation and allocation sections and a fiscal note.
