HOUSE AMENDMENT "**B**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 893, L.D. 2312, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Motor Vehicle Laws"

Amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the 3rd line (page 1, line 24 in amendment) by inserting before the following: "The" the following: 'A law enforcement officer may inspect toll receipts, but those toll receipts may not be used as evidence against the driver in court.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment allows a law enforcement officer to inspect a driver's toll receipts, but prohibits the use of those toll receipts in court as evidence against the driver.
