COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 893, L.D. 2312

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SUMMARY

4 This amendment stipulates that, while any law enforcement officer has the authority to inspect a driver's record of duty 6 status and medical certificate, only a properly trained officer may take enforcement action. This amendment removes section 4 of 8 the bill relating to passing emergency vehicles that are stopped. It also adds a fiscal note.
