COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1650, L.D. 2319, "Resolve, Authorizing the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services to Sell or Lease the Interests of the State in the Maine State Prison in Thomaston"

Amend the resolve in section 7 in the first line (page 2, line 32 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "3" and inserting in its place the following: '5'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This resolve authorizes the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services to sell or lease the Maine State Prison in Thomaston. The new Maine State Prison is being constructed on the grounds of the existing Maine Correctional Institution in Warren and will replace the facility in Thomaston effective November 2001.

The net impact of the sale or lease of the Thomaston property can not be determined at this time. Proceeds from the sale or lease will accrue to the General Fund. However, significant additional costs will be incurred to prepare the Thomaston property for sale or lease. The source and amount of the funding for these preparation costs have not been established.'
