Resolve, Authorizing the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services to Sell or Lease the Interests of the State in the Maine State Prison in Thomaston.

	Sec. 1. Definitions. Resolved: That as used in this resolve,
2	unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

6	1. "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services.
8	2. "State property" means the real and personal property described in section 3 of this resolve; and be it further
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12	Sec. 2. Authority to convey property. Resolved: That the State, by and through the commissioner, may:
14	1. Lease or sell the interests of the State in the state property;
16 18	2. Negotiate, draft, execute and deliver any documents necessary to settle any boundary line discrepancies;
20	3. Exercise, pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, chapter 3, the power of eminent domain to quiet for all time
22	any possible challenges to ownership of the state property;
24	4. Negotiate, draft, execute and deliver any easements or other rights that, in the commissioner's discretion, may
26	contribute to the value of a proposed sale or lease of the State's interests; and
28	5. Release any interests in the state property that, in the
30	commissioner's discretion, do not contribute to the value of the remaining state property; and be it further
32	Sec. 3. Property interests that may be conveyed. Resolved: That
34	the state property authorized to be sold or leased is the following:
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38	1. The Maine State Prison, located in Thomaston and comprised of land located on the northerly and southerly sides of U.S. Route 1, including but not limited to the following deeds

46	privileges and easements appurtenant thereto and together with all of the State's interest in and to the buildings, improvements
48	and personal property located thereon, including all vehicles, machinery, equipment and supplies; and be it further

Sec. 4. Property to be sold "as is." Resolved: That the commissioner may negotiate and execute leases and purchase and sale agreements upon those terms the commissioner considers appropriate; however, the state property must be sold "as is,"
without any representations or warranties.

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Title must be transferred by quitclaim deed without covenant and executed by the commissioner; and be it further

Sec. 5. Exemptions. Resolved: That any lease or conveyance pursuant to this resolve is exempt from any statutory or regulatory requirement that the property first be offered to the Maine State Housing Authority or another state or local agency; and be it further

Sec. 6. Purchase price. Resolved: That the commissioner shall have the current market value of the state property determined by an independent appraiser. The commissioner may list the property for sale or lease with private real estate brokers at its appraised value and negotiate sales or leases, solicit bids, sell directly to purchasers or enter directly into leases with tenants. The commissioner may reject any offers.

The commissioner shall establish the rent or purchase price 26 and the terms of lease or sale.

28 If the commissioner elects to solicit bids, the commissioner shall publish notices of sale sufficient to advertise the 30 property. The commissioner may reject any bids; and be it further

32 Sec. 7. Repealed. Resolved: That this resolve is repealed 3 years from its effective date.
