Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the 2 following: 'Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §523, sub-§2-A is enacted to read: 4 6 2-A. Disabled veterans motorcycle license plates. The Secretary of State shall issue a registration certificate and special designating plate for a motorcycle to be used in lieu of 8 a registration plate issued in subsection 2 to any 100% disabled 10 veteran if an applicant submits the following together with an application: 12 A. Evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Title 14 36, section 1482; and 16 Certification from the United States Veterans в. Administration or any branch of the United States Armed 18 Forces as to the veteran's permanent disability and receipt of 100% service-connected benefits. 20 Notwithstanding section 468, the Secretary of State may issue 22 fewer than 2,000 of the plates authorized by this subsection, and this plate does not require a sponsor. This bill includes a Highway Fund allocation of \$1,329 in 10 fiscal year 2000-01 for the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the Department of the Secretary of State to manufacture Purple Heart 12 motorcycle registration plates.

14 The issuance of Purple Heart motorcycle registration plates will increase registration fee collections. The estimated annual 16 increase of Highway Fund revenue to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles is \$300 beginning in fiscal year 2000-01.'

### SUMMARY

22 This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It exempts the special Purple Heart medal recipient motorcycle 24 license plate from the current sponsorship requirements for specialty license plates and breaks the text into subsections and 26 adds headnotes. The amendment also codifies the current practice of making a disabled veterans motorcycle license plate available 28 to qualified veterans.

30 The amendment also adds an allocation and a fiscal note to the bill.
