'FISCAL NOTE

4 The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to study the reimbursement rates for providers 6 of health care services under the Medicaid program. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted 8 resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. It amends the resolve to change the title. It amends the resolve to delete the directive to increase fees and calls for a study of reimbursement rates under the Medicaid program for all providers of health care services. It requires a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters by January 1, 2001. It adds a fiscal note to the resolve.

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
