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36 SUMMARY

- This amendment revises effective dates in newly enacted laws.
- Public Law 1999, chapter 598 amends the licensing laws of the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources. It applies to licenses issued or renewed beginning August 1, 2000. This amendment makes the chapter effective retroactively to August 1, 2000.
- Public Law 1999, chapter 674 restricts passengers in the vehicle of a newly licensed driver. This amendment repeals the section establishing August 1, 2000 as the effective date for the law.
