COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1667, L.D. 2336, "Resolve, to Provide Funds to the Bureau of Veterans' Services to Enhance the Efficiency of Regional Field Offices in Delivering Services to Veterans"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
