	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6446, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 468,
4	§8, is amended to read:
6	 Establishment of zones. The commissioner may establish by rule zones to facilitate local or regional management or
8	lobster fishery efforts. A lobster management zone may not extend beyond 3 nautical miles from the coastline of the State.

14	This bill limits lobster management zones to 3 nautical miles from the coastline of the State.
