Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted 2 as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, the Legislature instituted a limited entry system for the elver fishery, reduced the amount of gear a harvester 6 could actively use and decreased the length of the season; and 8 Whereas, the Legislature stated its intention to review the 10 1999 elver fishing season and make necessary adjustments for the 2000 season; and 12 Whereas, the 2000 elver fishing season commences on March 14 22nd; and Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 16 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 18 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 20 safety; now, therefore, 22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6505-A, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1999, c. 7, 24 $\S2$, is further amended to read: 26 2. It freezes the number of elver fishing licenses and gear at 1999 levels. The bill also raises the fees 30 for elver fishing licenses to \$120 for residents and \$421 for nonresidents and specifies that all license fees accrue to the 32 Eel and Elver Management Fund. 34 The bill repeals the provision that authorizes a person to use one net or trap to fish for elvers without paying a gear fee and changes the gear fees to \$25 per elver dip net and \$75 per 36 elver fyke or Sheldon eel trap. These changes to the elver 38 license and gear fees will increase funding to the Eel and Elver Management Fund to support further research on the eel and elver 40 fishery.
