Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides one-time funds for direct grants to local area agencies on aging to support the medical ride volunteer service that provides transportation. These funds must be used as direct pass-through money and may not be used for administrative costs. A portion of these funds may be used by the local area agencies on aging to develop an informational brochure to explain how to access the medical ride volunteer service.

10 **FISCAL NOTE**

12 This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by
\$50,000 in fiscal year 2000-01.

14 As amended, this bill includes a one-time General Fund
16 appropriation of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Bureau of
Elder and Adult Services within the Department of Human Services
18 to provide grants to local area agencies on aging to support the
medical ride volunteer service that provides transportation. It
20 also includes a one-time General Fund deappropriation of \$50,000
in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Purchased Social Services program
22 within the Department of Human Services to transfer funds to the
Bureau of Elder and Adult Services for the medical ride volunteer
24 service that provides transportation.

26 **SUMMARY**

28 This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriation
30 request from \$85,000 to \$50,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 and
clarifies that this one-time funding is pass-through money that
32 can not be used for administrative costs. The amendment also
transfers funds from the Purchased Social Services program within
34 the Department of Human Services to the Bureau of Elder and Adult
Services to support the medical ride volunteer service.
