20	This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$300,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the University of Maine System for the Maine Patent Program to be administered by the Center for
22	Advanced Technology Law and Management for staff and related operational costs and to conduct workshops and provide assistance
24	to help state inventors.
26	This bill also establishes the Maine Patent Fund. The amount of dedicated revenue that will be collected by the
28	University of Maine System from royalties received from applicants can not be determined at this time. This bill
30	includes an Other Special Revenue funds allocation in the amount of \$500 in fiscal year 2000-01 to provide base allocations to
32	authorize expenditures from this fund.'

36	SUMMARY
50	This amendment changes the administration of the Maine
38	Patent Program from the Secretary of State to the Center for Advanced Technology Law and Management in the University of Maine
40	System. The amendment also requires the Center for Advanced Technology Law and Management to submit a report on the
42	performance of the program by December 1, 2001. Finally, the amendment changes the appropriation from \$100,000 to \$300,000 and
44	adds a fiscal note to the bill.
