It also requires the center to report on its 40 progress in pursuing alternative funding sources and the status 42 of its efforts to achieve certification to the joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs and health and human 44 services matters no later than February 15, 2001. 46 This amendment clarifies that the Maine Poison Center must seek funding from other sources. 48

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

- This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$255,000 28 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Human Services to
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
