

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1301, sub-§3, ¶D**, as enacted by PL 1981, c.
693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

8 D. If approved by this meeting, the change shall must be
submitted to the voters at a district meeting. It shall
10 become becomes effective when approved by a majority vote ~~of~~
the-district of those voting in each of the municipalities
in a district referendum called and held for this purpose in
12 accordance with sections 1351 to 1354.

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SUMMARY

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18 This bill provides that a cost-sharing formula for a school
administrative district may only be changed if the change is
20 approved by a majority of those voting in each of the
municipalities in a school administrative district referendum.
Current law provides that such a change may occur if approved by
22 a majority vote of the district.
