SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1699, L.D. 2405, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Number of Domestic Violence Prosecutors"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th and 5th paragraphs (page 1, lines 38 to 42 in amendment) after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Federal Expenditures Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
