HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1706, L.D. 2412, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Process for a County Bond Referendum Election"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§938.~~" by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. Review. After public hearing, the appropriate county budget committee, if there is one, shall review the county bond issue question. In a county where there is a budget committee, the county commissioners may conduct a referendum election pursuant to this section only if the budget committee recommends the referendum by at least a 2/3 vote.'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~§938.~~" by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires a review by a county budget committee, if there is one, after public hearing and a 2/3 affirmative vote by that committee before the county commissioners may conduct a county bond referendum election.
