26	pursuant to this section only if the budget committee recommends the referendum by at least a 2/3 vote.

30	Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "§938." by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

34	SUMMARY
36	This amendment requires a review by a county budget committee, if there is one, after public hearing and a 2/3
38	affirmative vote by that committee before the county commissioners may conduct a county bond referendum election.
