COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1709, L.D. 2415, Bill, "An Act to Remove Certain Barriers for Low-income Working Parents"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 13 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "that include a minor child, but" and inserting in its place the following: 'in which there is a child who would be a dependent child under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program but that'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to adopt rules that maximize access to the food stamp program for certain households. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes references in the bill to "minor child" to "child who would be a dependent child under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program," and adds a fiscal note.
