_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §600 is enacted to read:
* 6	§600. Temporary employee
0	An employer may not hire a temporary employee for a period
8	greater than 90 days unless the temporary employee is replacing a permanent employee who is absent from work on family medical
10	leave pursuant to subchapter VI-A.
