	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1519 is enacted to read:
	§1519. Assistance to private companies
	If a private company receives state assistance and does not
	follow reporting procedures required by law, the company nay not receive any further state assistance until the company meets all
	reporting requirements. For the purposes of this section, "state assistance" means any form of financial assistance from the
5	State, including, but not limited to, a grant or tax incentive, but not including a loan or fee for services.
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	SUMMARY
	This bill withholds further state subsidies from a private company that has received a state subsidy and has not followed
	required reporting procedures.
