HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1731, L.D. 2437, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Funding of the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund"


Amend the amendment in section 2 in the last 5 lines (page 2, lines 14 to 18 in amendment) by striking out the following: "matters, which may report out a bill regarding field-constructed bulk storage tanks to the First Regular Session of the 120th Legislature and a bill regarding the regulation of aboveground oil storage tanks to the Second Regular Session of the 120th Legislature." and inserting in its place the following: 'matters.'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the last 5 lines (page 2, lines 37 to 41 in amendment) by striking out all of the last sentence.

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the last 5 lines (page 3, lines 15 to 19 in amendment) by striking out all of the last sentence.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the authority of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resource matters to report out legislation regarding the reports received from the Department of Environmental Protection.
