

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1744, L.D. 2450, Bill, "An Act to Restrict Passengers in the Vehicle of a Newly Licensed Driver"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 28-A in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 30 and 31 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or sister" and inserting in its place the following: 'sister; child; stepchild; or other child for whom the person is a legal guardian or custodian'

SUMMARY

This amendment includes in the definition of "immediate family member" a child, stepchild or other child for whom the person is a legal guardian or custodian to allow those persons to be passengers in vehicles driven by a person under 21 years of age who has been licensed for less than 90 days.
