

SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1744, L.D. 2450, Bill, "An Act to Restrict Passengers in the Vehicle of a Newly Licensed Driver"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the part designated "~~S1310.~~" in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "21" and inserting in its place the following: '18'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that a person under 18 years of age who has been issued a driver's license may not carry passengers other than immediate family members unless accompanied by a licensed operator who meets certain requirements for a period of 90 days from license issuance. Committee Amendment "A" provides that this restriction applies to a person under 21 years of age.
