2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1310** is enacted to read:

6 **§1310. Passengers restricted**

8 A person under 21 years of age may not transport a passenger  
10 other than a family member for 90 days after being issued a  
12 license unless another person 21 years of age or older is also in  
14 the vehicle.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill restricts new drivers under 21 years of age from transporting passengers other than family members for the first 90 days of their license unless another person 21 years of age or older is also in the vehicle.
