22	This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by
24	\$40,613 in fiscal year 2000-01. As amended, this bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$10,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural
26	Resources to establish a pilot project to conduct additional spot checks at timber mills.

30	SUMMARY
32	This amendment replaces the original bill. It provides for an additional one-time appropriation of \$10,000 to the Division
34	of Quality Assurance and Regulation for additional spot checks to determine the accuracy of wood measurements and to enforce the
36	wood measurement laws. It requires the Director of the Division of Quality Assurance and Regulation to report to the Legislature
38	by February 15, 2001 on the enhanced monitoring.
