The estimated future costs will be approximately \$54,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 2001-02. 34 The additional workload and administrative costs associated 36 with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial 38 Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.' 40 42 SUMMARY 44 This amendment clarifies that the state sealer is being directed to do spot checks to determine the accuracy of wood 46 measurements and to enforce the wood measurement laws. It. removes the specification that the spot checks be random.
