## HOUSE AMENDMENT

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1755,

Study Economically and Socially Just Policies on Investments and Purchasing by the State and to print the required report.

The additional costs associated with providing staffing during the interim between assistance to the commission legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. If an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the commission requires staffing assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services.

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The additional costs associated with serving on commission can be absorbed by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services and the Maine State Retirement System utilizing existing budgeted resources.

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## **SUMMARY**

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This amendment changes the composition of the commission membership. It adds 2 members, one representing labor unions and one representing manufacturing and industry. The amendment removes the Treasurer of State and a representative from the Maine State Retirement System as members. The amendment replaces the representative from the Maine State Retirement System with 2 representatives from retail business. The amendment also strikes and replaces the appropriation section.
